Dear Students,
Uddhavdas Mehta was born on 9, August 1910 in a reputed family of Bhopal. After completing the degree in Sanskrit and Ayurveda from Kashi, he started his clinical practice. Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya ji was his idol, He devoted his life for Hindi, Hindu and Hindustan. Being an Ayurvedic practitioner he used to treat the lower economic people free of cost and also performed social services with priorities. His struggle against the terror and exploitation against the nawabi regime of Bhopal state gave consolation to hindu community. As a mark of respect he became popular by the name Bhaiji. Soon he started his public life in 1926. He presented memorandum to nawab of Bhopal in 1930 on the behalf of hindu conference. In 1934, He started publishing one weekly hindi magazine named Praja Pukar. In 1937 he was arrested for leading first freedom movement and imprisoned for a period of six months. Thereafter he became Sanghchalak in Bhopal in 1940 and was arrested in 1944 again while addressing a rally. People became violent when he was arrested in 1949 while leading vileenikaran movement. Basically, he was a physician as well as a social worker but due to existing situation of Bhopal state he was compelled to lead the hindu mahasabha. Later on he joined Jansangh on humble request of Late Kusabhau Thakreji and Late Pt. Deenadayal Upadhyayji. Although he joined active politics but could not leave his active social services. He had established an excellent coordination between profession, social services and politics. These were the qualities and reason of Bhaiji to ruled over the heart of people. Even today, He is remembered with full respect and love for his excellent personality and contribution to the society. Vishwa Ayurved Parishad M.P.
